PURPOSE: Research, preserve, and promote the accurate history of the United States Army Buffalo Soldiers, and in particular highlight the detachment which served at the United States Military Academy from 1907 to 1947. Our focus is starting with the historical timeline from the period directly after the Civil War, when a law was enacted by Congress forming four all black segregated regiments, the 9th & 10th Cavalry Regiments, and the 24th & 25th Infantry Regiments. The 9th Cavalry Regiment was activated in Greenville, Louisiana and the 10th Cavalry Regiment was activated in Fort Leavenworth Kansas on the same day. The transition from being volunteers during the Civil War to many accomplishments made during the decades following the Civil War must be known by members of the association. We are dedicated to informing society and the community of the significant contributions made by the Buffalo Soldiers that served at the United States Military Academy to this country's rich history. We honor our heritage by performing community service that enhances and promotes social, emotional, academic development, and resilience. The methods used to share information about the Buffalo Soldiers include: implementing a historically based curriculum that covers 1864-1947, promoting S.T.E.A.M programs that impact historically underrepresented students and their families, as well as provides Veteran Transition Support, community engagement programs, and equine wellness programs and services. In addition to the above advancements the Association also provides presentations at schools, churches, annual community events, and will participate in community projects that promote, honor, acknowledge, and preserve the legacy of the Buffalo Soldiers in America and beyond.
